THE SATURDAY CLUB PRESENTS FALL 2010 GRANTS TO PETER'S PLACE, T&E CARE AND THE WOMEN'S CENTER OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY

WAYNE, PA – November 11, 2010 – The Saturday Club is pleased to announce its Fall 2010 grants, awarded to Peter's Place, T&E Care and the Women's Center of Montgomery County. The grants, which were presented at the Club's membership meeting on November 9, will be used to establish and enhance programs and provide key support.

The Saturday Club is one of the oldest women's clubs in the country, founded in 1886 as a forum for the education and cultural enrichment of women. Today, the Club's mission has expanded to include direct service and philanthropic support to charitable organizations in the greater Philadelphia area. Funds for these grants were raised via fundraisers and projects throughout 2009 and 2010, including the American Girl Fashion Shows.

Peter's Place was founded in memory of 10-year-old Peter Morsbach, providing a safe and supportive environment for grieving children and families and acting as a community resource to foster understanding of the effects of death and grief. The Saturday Club Grant will be used to sponsor 6 in-school support groups for grieving students in economically disadvantaged communities.

T&E Care's mission is to maintain a network of people providing financial and other material assistance by identifying persons in need through contacts in the community; communicating with those in need; and facilitating the delivery of such assistance. The Saturday Club Grant will be used to fund the School Meal Assistance Program, which provides school meals for local students whose families are experiencing a financial hardship but do not qualify for the federally-funded program.

The Women's Center of Montgomery County is a volunteer community organization with a primary focus on freedom from domestic violence and other forms of abuse. The organization's programs,

policies and procedures reflect their strong commitment to empowering women. The Saturday Club Grant will support the Healthy Relationships Program for preschool-aged children. .

“Our commitment to philanthropy and community service is one of the most important aspects of The Saturday Club,” said Jeanne Dechiario, Saturday Club President. “Peter’s Place, T&E Care and the Women’s Center of Montgomery County are shining examples of local organizations making a difference for women and children in our region, and we are pleased to be able to present these grants to help them achieve their very worthy goals.”
